

### General Policies for all Grade Levels

All Students enrolled in the program are required to:

1. Attend class and participate to the best of their ability.
2. Show respectful behavior to the catechists and fellow classmates.
3. Have **no more than 4 excused absences** from class.
4. Complete any missed assignments.
5. Early release: a parent/guardian must come in to get the child and sign them out.
6. Attend and participate at all liturgical events and class functions.
7. Call the Religious Education office to report an absence or tardy.
8. We are a **NO PEANUT** facility due to the danger of allergies.

### Parents/Guardians are encouraged to:

1. Attend weekly Mass with your child.
2. Review each week's lesson with your child.
3. Reinforce prayer, spiritual reading/rituals in the home.
4. Occasionally attend and/or help at special events.

### Children should know the following prayers by:

Kindergarten:	Sign of the Cross, Grace Before Meals
First Grade:	Hail Mary, Glory Be, Guardian Angel
Second Grade:	Our Father, Act of Contrition
Third Grade:	Apostle's Creed
Fourth Grade:	Nicene Creed
Fifth Grade:	How to pray the Rosary with Mysteries
Sixth Grade:	All the Mass Prayers
Level 1 & 2:	Prayer to the Holy Spirit & all the above

*(Attending Mass regularly with consistent family prayer times will help your child/children learn these prayers that will bless them forever!)*

### Drop off/Pick up procedures:

1. Drop children off at the Maple St. or 4<sup>th</sup> Street doors.
2. Earliest arrival time is 3:50 pm / 5:50 pm.
3. All grades gather in the gym first (3:55pm / 5:55pm) for songs of praise, announcements, etc. *Parents are welcome to join us!*
4. Pick up is **promptly** at 5:30 pm / 7:30 pm. (use gym doors)
5. Kindergarten children will be escorted downstairs to the gym door (Maple St. side) for pick up. First and Second grade will be picked up outside of their classroom.

### Weather Cancellation Policy

If the public schools close **due to inclement weather**, we will close as well. Call the Religious Education office: 734-285-9840 ext. 102 whenever in doubt.

### "Circle of Grace"

The "Circle of Grace", a safe environment program, will be taught in every grade. If you would like to see the curriculum or you wish for your child to opt out, you must notify the office before September 30 and we will make arrangements for your request.

### Program Fees:

Tuition is as follows: One child - \$80  
Two children - \$110  
Three or more- \$130

NOTE: **Deduct \$10** on the above tuition fee if you submit your registration form and make any payment by August 15<sup>th</sup>.

Sacrament Preparation Fee (covers added materials and retreats)  
First Reconciliation/First Eucharist - \$35  
Confirmation (Level 2) - \$35

Payments (partial or full) are accepted in the parish office or on any religious education night.

Checks are made payable to: St. Vincent Pallotti Parish

All accounts **MUST** be **paid in full by January 30<sup>th</sup>**. Financial hardship? Please contact us so we can discuss other arrangements.

### Seeking a Sacrament? You must:

1. Provide a copy of each child's baptismal certificate.
2. Attend **ALL** scheduled parent meetings and retreats.
3. Assure good weekly class attendance of your child.
4. Help with prayers and other spiritual guidance.
5. Attend Mass regularly.

*An original Baptism Certificate **MUST** be submitted before sacrament preparation can take place unless the baptism was at St. Elizabeth, St. Joseph, St. Patrick or St. Vincent Pallotti Parish.*

### Sacrament Preparation

First Eucharist – takes place in the child's second year of formation (usually the second grade). Additional meetings and retreats are required.

Confirmation – a two year preparation program (Level 1 & Level 2.) Group service projects are part of the confirmation prep and Level 2 students will attend additional classes on a Sunday evening, 6-8:00pm

Older children seeking Baptism or Eucharist – Please call the religious education office to discuss the best plan for your child's preparation.
